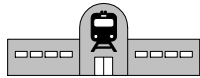


Custom Electronics own Boddington Lodge on London Road. A large victorian property in its own grounds set back off the road. Look for the Custom and Levitt signs at the end of the driveway. There is ample carparking available.

From the North, pass through the town centre onto the main London Rd, we are on the left after the Council offices, about 0.4 mile from town.

From the South, head towards the town centre on London Road, we are 1 mile from the A1 on the right, just after Jack Bygraves Ford Car Dealer.



By Train or Plane:
Biggleswade is 35 minutes out of London Kings Cross Station. A service is available either once or twice hourly at most times of the day.



From M25
Join A1M at Jn 23
Travel North past Hatfield and Stevenage to the 1st roundabout on the A1 at Biggleswade South.



From M11
Exit at Jn 12 near Cambridge. Take A603 signposted Sandy, but continue through Edworth and Dunton straight into Biggleswade, arriving at London Rd from the South.



From M1
Exit at Jn 13 and head for Bedford on A421
Skirt the town on the South bypass and head for Sandy A603. Join the A1 and head South to Biggleswade.



From M6
Either carry onto the A14 then South down the A1 past Sandy to Biggleswade. Or Join the M1 south to Jn 13.
